

BARN RULES, PROTOCOLS, AND PROCEDURES

Rules

- Barn hours are from 8 AM – 9 PM Monday through Sunday
- The riding of another boarder's horse or use of another boarder's tack is not permitted without that boarder's permission
- No lunging is permitted without prior arrangements unless in one of the outdoor round pens
- No free lunging in the arenas
- No riding in the outdoor arenas when standing water is present
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM approved helmet
- Closed toe shoes must be worn when handling horses, no sandals permitted in areas where there are horses
- Do not handle, enter stall, or feed treats to any horse other than your own without the permission of the owner

Protocols

Here at CREC, we encourage a community atmosphere and work on the “good neighbor” philosophy. There are many amenities in the barn available for your use such as the grooming area, the wash rack, and the first aid kits. We only ask that if you use these amenities, you clean up after yourself, put things back where you found them, and replenish the supplies you use, such as shampoo or vet supplies.

Also for your consideration

- Please turn barn, office, tack room, grooming area, and arena lights off when you leave if no one else is present
- Please put up barn aisle doorway barriers when you leave if no one else is present
- Clean up after yourself: put tack away, clean up manure, sweep the grooming areas and aisles, etc.
